Loving the Lost - Cabiari of Colombia

The Pingdi Yao believe in a god of creation named Tin Zay, but they do not know the Creator God. Of the 1.7 million Pingdi Yao, less than 500 are Christian. Gospel materials are available in their language, but for years they have lived in darkness with no local church or missionary to preach the gospel. *Pray the Pindi Yao will cry out to God today, hear the gospel, trust in Jesus and be saved.* (Isaiah 59:1)

Praying for the Persecuted Church: Togo

Influenced by neighboring Benin, the birthplace of voodoo, persecution against Christians occurs primarily in the north of Togo, where voodooists and animists oppose the church because they see it as a threat to their power and influence. Members of the Muslim Fulani tribe who choose to follow Christ also experience opposition from their families and communities. *Pray for the safety of Christians threatened by militant Fulani Muslims.*

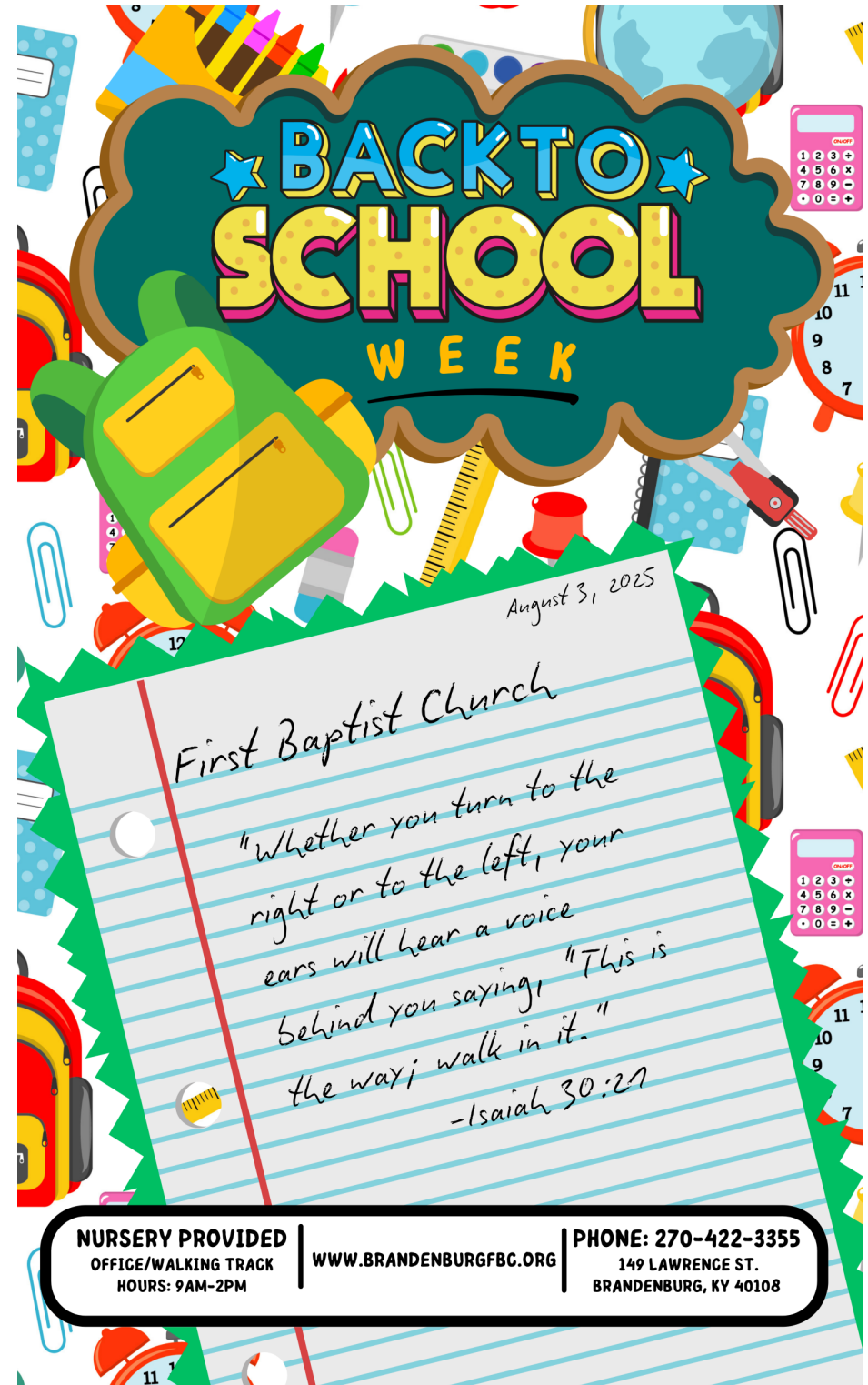
